	sure this information is passed on to your attendees.
	What are the qualifications of the Spa staff? How long has each staff
	member been employed by the facility?
	How many treatment rooms are available? What is their condition?
	How many of the following are at the facility – Whirlpools, saunas, steam
	rooms and lap pools?
	Are staff members there to instruct guests in proper use of fitness and
	weight-training equipment?
	Are programs flexible enough to accommodate a variety of goals, fitness
	levels and preferences?
	Are separate changing areas available for men and women and are
	lockers provided?
	Are quite rooms separate for men and women or one unisex quite room?
	Is there an attendant stationed in each waiting area?
	Are robes and footwear provided?
	Where is the spa located relative to meeting facilities, guest rooms and
	public areas? Does it have its own entrance?
	How does the spa handle guest complaints?
	Is there a CPR Certified staff member on-site and available at all times
	during spa hours?
	Does the spa have its own restaurant and spa menu?
	What is the cancellation/no-show policy? Are deposits required?
